INDICTMENT

The Grand Jurors of the State of Maryland for the body of Wicomico County do on their Oath present that

COUNT I

From on or about May 22, 2018 and through and including on or about September 6, 2018, at Wicomico County, Maryland, MICHAEL F. MCCOMAS, did, corruptly and in violation and perversion of his duties as a duly sworn Sergeant of the Maryland State Police to uphold, enforce, and obey the laws of the State of Maryland without partiality or prejudice, commit misconduct in office by knowingly, willfully, and intentionally, under the color of his office, notifying a subordinate employee that they were the target of a search and seizure warrant which allowed the subordinate employee the opportunity to remove items from their personal residence prior to the execution of the lawful search and seizure warrant, in violation of the common law and against the peace, government and dignity of the State.


