
**COUNT ONE**

The Maryland State Prosecutor informs the Court and charges that NICHOLAS GONZALEZ, late of Dorchester County, Maryland, on or about the 29<sup>th</sup> day of December, 2018, in Dorchester County, Maryland, did corruptly and in violation and perversion of his duties as a duly sworn officer for the Cambridge Police Department in Cambridge, Maryland to uphold, enforce, and obey the laws of the State of Maryland, commit misconduct in office by knowingly, willfully, and intentionally, under the color of his office by unlawfully detaining M.F., in violation of the common law, contrary to the form of the act of the assembly in such case made and provided and against the peace, government, and dignity of the State.
